SPIROMETRY UPDATE TRAINING

Course Content:

This update session is designed for healthcare professionals who are responsible for performing, recording and interpreting spirometry in adults, or a combination of these. The aim of the session is to provide an overview of the importance of Spirometry, including guidance on how to correctly perform Spirometry with a brief introduction to interpretation.

The objectives of the session are to enable the learner:

- To understand Spirometry and what it tells us
- To understand how to ensure quality assured Spirometry
- To understand the training undertaken and the ARTP assessments
- To provide guidance on how to perform Spirometry
- To provide a basic understanding of interpretation

By undertaking this session, the learner should acquire:

- An understanding of the importance of Spirometry
- An understanding of the Spirometry learning journey and ARTP Assessments*
- The knowledge of which guidelines to use in Spirometry
- The ability to perform Spirometry
- A basic understanding of interpretation

*During the session, the importance of quality assured Spirometry will be discussed including the training that we can provide to prepare learners to undertake the ARTP assessments if they wish to do so. Our full Spirometry course is available to those wishing to undertake this training; it is an online, interactive course which combines master classes, podcasts and eLearning in several distinct chapters, support by live monthly tutor sessions. It provides the knowledge and 'know how' to demonstrate competence in spirometry and is written by a team of expert clinicians, aligned with ARTP standards.
