Course summary

The aim of the course is to provide opportunities to develop and demonstrate knowledge, understanding, and skills in prescribing practice through independent reasoned thought, systematic enquiry, reflection and evaluation. The course covers the following topics:

- Systematic approaches to assessment and diagnosis
- Pharmacodynamics and pharmacokinetics
- Factors that influence prescribing practice and patients' use of medication
- Evidence-based sources of information
- Legal, professional and ethical issues associated with the role

Pre-requisites

Nurses

- You must be a level 1 Registered Nurse
- You need to have at least three years' experience in practice, with at least one years' full-time relevant experience immediately prior to your application in the area of your intended prescribing practice

AHPs

- You must be employed in one of the following roles;
 - Physiotherapist
 - Podiatrists
 - Therapeutic Radiographers
 - Paramedics
- Have a minimum of three years' experience in their area of intended prescribing
- Registered with the HCPC
