Postgraduate Diploma in General Practice January 2022 intake

BLMK Training Hub are pleased to be able to offer funded places on the Postgraduate Diploma (PG Dip) in General Practice at the Anglia Ruskin University. This course is open to Nurses and AHPs. It is part-time over 2 years and the intake date is January 22.

Course summary

The Postgraduate Diploma in General Practice is equivalent to 120 CPD credits. The course is a blended approach of distance learning and face to face lectures at the University campus of Chelmsford or Cambridge (tbc).

Over the course of your Postgraduate Diploma, you'll build your knowledge in the classroom and in practice. You'll complete 4 compulsory modules covering fundamentals, skills, assessments and leadership. You'll also have the choice of an optional module, which range from mental health to wound care and minor injuries, allowing you to solidify existing knowledge and delve into a specialism (modules are subject to change and availability).

Core modules; Fundamentals of Practice Nursing; Enhanced Practice Nursing; Assessment; Skills for Community Practitioners; Leadership and Management in the Community

Optional modules; Advanced Management of Minor Injuries; Wound Management; Advanced Non-Medical Prescribing*; Specialist Mental Health Care; Minor Illness Assessment and Management; Advanced Management of Persons with Diabetes across the Primary & Secondary Healthcare Settings; Pathophysiology for Advanced Practice.

Course pre-requisites:

Undergraduate health care related degree (minimum of 2:2)*
Current relevant healthcare registration
