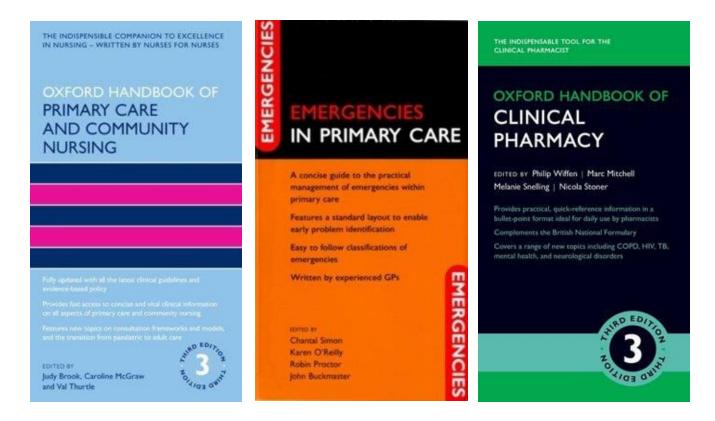

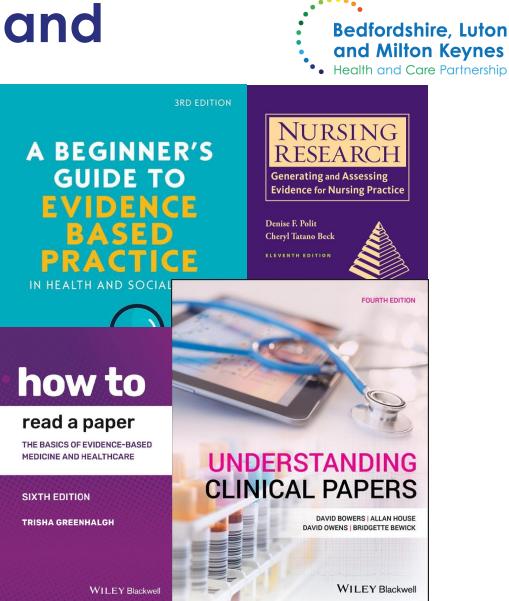

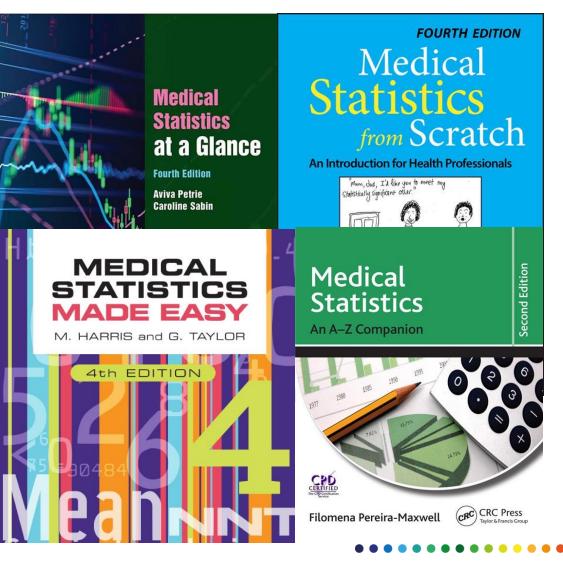

Getting started with research



- Define your topic: How to clarify a clinical question
 - P: Population I: Intervention C: Comparison O: Outcomes
- Try some basic scoping searches in Cochrane, PubMed or Google Scholar – see what's out there
- Gather keywords and synonyms to inform your searches
- Consider ethics approval via <u>hra.nhs.uk</u>
