Advanced Practice MSc & Advanced Practice Top-up MSc

BLMK Training Hub are pleased to be able to offer funded places for the Advanced Clinical Practice MSc (180 credits) and Advanced Clinical Practice Top-up MSc (up to 100 credits) for registered healthcare professionals working in General Practice in Bedfordshire, Luton or Milton Keynes.

Funded places are available at the University of Bedfordshire, University of Northamptonshire, Oxford Brookes University or Anglia Ruskin University. The course duration is 3 years for the full MSc and 2 years for the top-up.

The University will assess the candidates eligibility to apply for the course and will include an assessment prior to learning. Applications will be jointly approved by the University and the BLMK Training Hub.

Practices supporting successful applicants on the full MSc course will receive some financial support from the Training Hub for clinical supervision.

Eligibility and pre-requisites: Candidate

- UK Registered healthcare professional with current registration
- A first degree (or equivalent) in a health-related discipline
- Minimum three year's relevant post-qualification experience
- Applicants must have evidence of level 2 Math's and English functional skills
- Employed for a minimum of 30 hours per week (full ACP MSc only)

Pre-requisites: Employer

- The employer will provide a named mentor/supervisor and ensure that appropriate clinical support, supervision and assessment as required by the course
- Provision of an ACP training post will be provided during the education period and employment to an ACP post on qualification by the employer

Funding

Please note that funding for the MSc ACP is done via an apprenticeship route. The employer will need to apply for an apprenticeship funding to cover the course fees (full MSc only). Health Education England and BLMK Training Hub will support the employer with the application process.
