## **Credits towards PG Diploma in Pharmacy Practice** **Intake dependent on module**

Please note that we can't accept applications from anyone currently completing the CPPE pathway unless you are due to complete before the course you are applying for.**

Funding will apply to credits for individual modules which can be used towards completion of the PG Diploma in Pharmacy Practice. There are a range of modules to apply for. Credits obtained will be eligible towards the PG Diploma for 5 years.

### Modules

The below are all 15 credits each and take approx. 3 months to complete:

- Clinical Patient Assessment & Consultation\*
- Clinical Patient Care 1 (CVD, Renal/Hepatic diseases & Antimicrobial Stewardship)\*
- Evidence Based Provision of Pharmaceutical Services\*
- Clinical Patient Care 2 (Advanced CVD, Advanced Renal/Hepatic diseases, Diabetes)\*
- Clinical Patient Care 3 (Respiratory, Gastroenterology, Neurological & Psychiatric diseases)\*
- Parenteral drug administration and therapeutic drug monitoring
- Pharmaceutical care for older people
- Paediatric pharmaceutical care
- Pharmaceutical care in oncology

\*Indicates a mandatory module if intending to seek the full PG Dip.

The below are all 30 credits each and take approx. 3 months to complete:

- Service Review & Improvement
- Evidence Based Practice
- Therapeutics of skin conditions
- Service Development Project
- Independent Prescribing
- Promoting Health
- Leadership, education & developing others

The below is 60 credits

- Research Project

Learners may study modules individually for development, plan to complete enough modules to gain credits for the PG Diploma or plan completion of modules to gain the PG Diploma. Please note that credits need to be funded within the 2023/24 financial year and you will need to ensure you are enrolled by 31st March 2024 for any modules where the start dates is after this date.
