## **Digital Nurse Placements**

Building on the success of previous Digital Nurse Placements, a 3rd year student program will be running as follows: Placement would start on the week of 7th October for 5 weeks. We are anticipating:

- Week 1 in practice Wednesday, Thursday, Friday (virtual from home Monday and Tuesday)
- Week 2 in practice Wednesday, Thursday, Friday (virtual from home Monday and Tuesday)
- Weeks 3 and 4 in practice full time
- Week 5 in practice Monday to Thursday then the last day being virtual from home.

Other areas offering these placements have seen 86% of students apply for nursing roles in General Practice upon completion. This serves as a vocational interview, with students qualifying in Sept 2025 and seeking jobs early to mid 2025.

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On June 20th, Jay, Yuliya, and Helen attended the Luton Integrated Neighbourhood Collaborative meeting at the Youth Centre to present our team's efforts in supporting the General Practice and Primary Care Network workforce through Integrated Neighbourhood Working. The afternoon was enlightening as we learned about various initiatives in Luton, including an impressive project by eQuality PCN and Father Luke from St Andrew's Church: the Biscot Peace and Wellbeing Hub. This hub unites community organizations and offers residents activities ranging from gardening to Zumba classes. We're eager to discuss their project further on our upcoming podcast series.
